

## **Roosevelt Fire District**

**Standard Operating Guidelines** 

Section: Guideline 21:
Operations ATV/UTV Operation

**Purpose:** This guideline was created to ensure firefighter safety while operating UTV/ ATVs.

**Scope:** This procedure applies to all members of the Roosevelt Fire District.

**Training:** All members who operate the Roosevelt Fire District ATV/UTV shall be trained on its use and operation before being approved to operate it. A list of all qualified operators shall be maintained by the Chief of the Department

## **Procedure:**

- 1. Perform a pre-ride inspection before vehicle operation
- 2. Check fuel level before and after use
- 3. Do not drive the ATV/UTV where there is a steep slope (vehicle is top heavy)
- 4. Do not allow passengers except in an emergency (deemed so by the Incident Commander), or the vehicle has a passenger seat and seatbelts
- 5. Start vehicle in Park with Handbrake secured.
- 6. Use low gear when operating vehicle off-road
- 7. Drivers and passengers must always keep arms and legs within the confines of the vehicle
- 8. Any equipment stored or carried in rear area shall be secured
- 9. Proper PPE shall be worn, when using the vehicle
- 10. If the ATV/UTV is to be loaded or unloaded when the trailer is not connected to a vehicle, ensure the rear stabilizing legs are in the down position first and wheels are chocked.
